As a Court Support volunteer you will be working within a highly regarded and valued team of volunteers.

Duties you will perform include:

- registering, assisting and directing clients on arrival at court and handling general enquiries
- recording clients request and referring clients to available court services
- liaising with Court Stakeholders
- registering Legal Representatives' arrival as required
- identifying clients ready for court to the Police Prosecutor.

If you are looking for a meaningful and challenging volunteer role, becoming a Court Support Volunteer with Centacare might be for you.

The role requires energetic, mature, non-judgmental men and women with a down to earth, common sense approach to life and its challenges, along with a happy disposition and excellent people skills.

You will receive the required training and induction to the court. Training or a background in law is not required. A current Blue Card and consent for Centacare to conduct a criminal history check along with other volunteer compliance is mandatory.

A willingness to work within the Vision, Mission and Values of the Catholic Church is essential.
