



Instructions.

1. 15cm x 15cm square of any colour – preferably plain.
2. Fold in half with right side together both directions.
3. Open out with right side down and fold diagonally both directions.
4. Fold the centre crease in on either side down to the crease in the middle of the bottom edge. It will look like image 5.
5. Now fold the top corner sections up so the points meet at the middle like in 6.
6. Try to keep as even as possible, lining the edges up together (but there may be a little bit of overlap).
7. Flip your butterfly over so it looks like image 7.
8. Fold the lower tip of the triangle (leaving the flaps behind it) up to it goes about 0.5cm past the flat edge of the triangle. (Your paper will “buckle” a little, this is a good thing.)
9. Then fold that 0.5cm of tip behind the top edge. Try not to crease the joints highlighted in the circles.
10. Now flip the butterfly over and fold in half and crease down the centre fold (remember to keep the ‘tip’ bit folded over too).
